



And speaking of “full,” did you know Parker's [Environmental Management Services](#) division (EMS) was the first contractor in Virginia licensed to perform in-place tank closures using the Petro Fill® process? If you're unfamiliar with this process, let us fill you in on it. The recently released *Virginia Guide to Heating Oil Storage Tanks* reminds us that **any homeowner with an underground storage tank (UST) should have that tank removed or properly abandoned before moving to a new house.** Homeowners might also consider having USTs inspected and sealed off if they're old or were handed down by a previous owner.

While the process of excavating and disposing of a tank can be costly and complicated, the Petro Fill® Underground Tank Abandonment Process is not. To safely close your underground tank, EMS uses a specially designed compound called Petro Sorb® that absorbs any leftover water, mud or sludge. We then pump the tank full of a blended polyurethane foam that sets like concrete. **The whole procedure takes about 4-6 hours and has been completed without incident hundreds of times over the past 26 years.** All you have to do is [contact EMS](#) and ask to schedule a closure. It's that simple!
